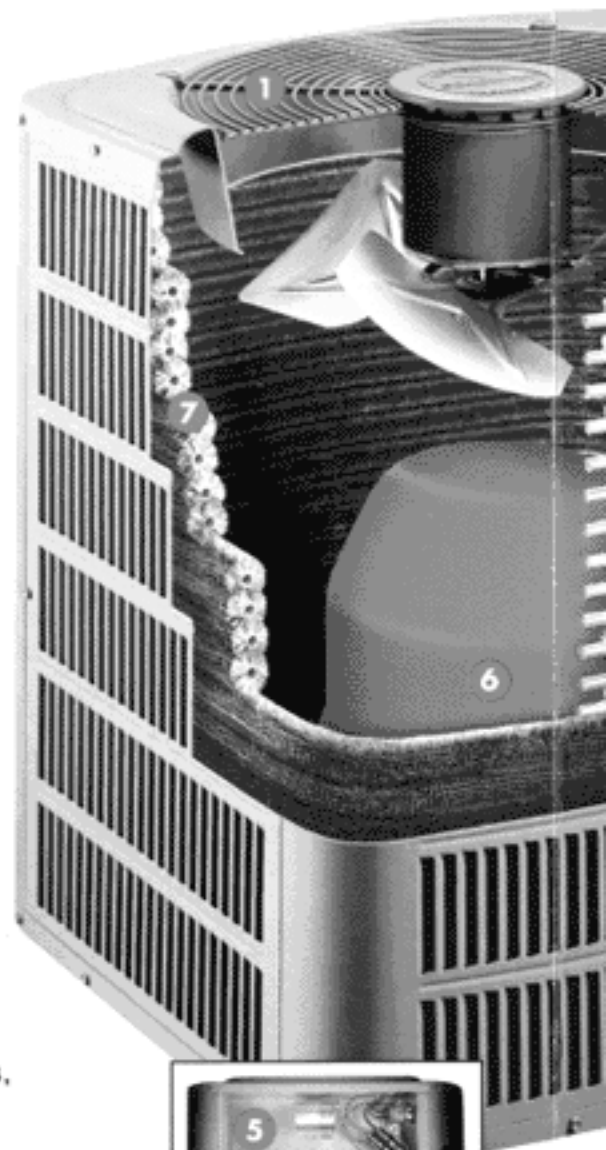

The Allegiance 12 uses less energy than older units. Its computer designed airflow system leads to greater efficiencies, which means you can save money on your cooling bills - in fact, annual savings of up to 50 percent are quite possible.

- 1 The recessed fan grille, along with the cabinet's rounded corners and "no snag" edges make the Allegiance 12 safe for any backyard.
- 2 Baked on powder paint protects the cabinet from scratches, rust and corrosion, and makes sure your unit won't show its age.
- 3 Ceramic coated screws resist rust and corrosion and prevent ugly rust streaks on the cabinet.
- 4 Full-side louvered panels are designed to protect the coil from weedwackers, lawn mowers, leaves, hail and other damaging elements.
- 5 Single-side service allows all electrical and refrigeration components to be easily serviced by simply removing one side panel.
- 6 The Duration™ compressor is tough enough to withstand the constant demands of cooling your home year after year.
- 7 All aluminum spine fin coil construction provides low airflow resistance.



WHY A HIGHER EFFICIENCY RATING CAN SAVE YOU MONEY.

* Seasonal Energy Efficiency Ratings (SEER) are established according to Air Conditioning & Refrigeration Institute procedures. Efficiency ratings and savings estimates will vary depending on the system size and matching of the outdoor unit and indoor blower/coil.

Estimated Annual Cooling Cost Comparisons.

If your current air conditioner is more than 10 years old, it could be as low as a 6.00 SEER. Compare the annual cooling bill of a 6.00 SEER system to that of a new system with a higher SEER, such as American Standard's 10.00, 11.00 or 12.00. For instance, if the annual cooling bill of a 6.00 SEER system was \$1000, it could cost only \$500 for a 12.00 SEER system, or an annual savings of 50%. Now, that makes dollars and sense, doesn't it?

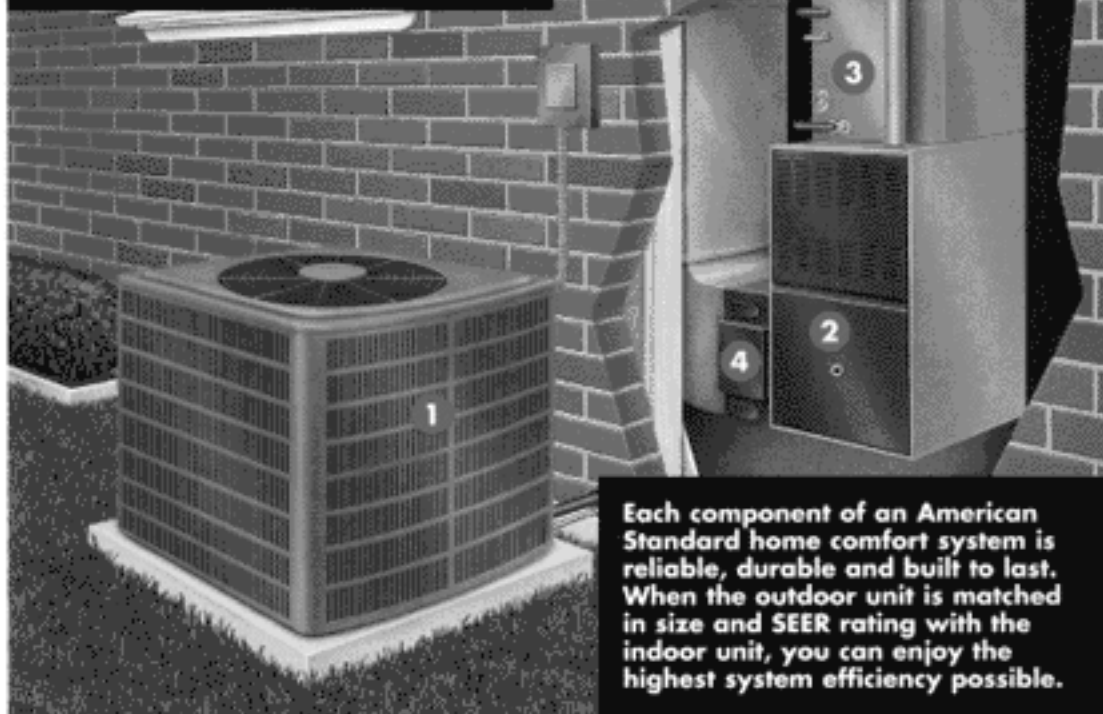
